... Montana Income Tax Credit

The Montana Income Tax Credit was developed to encourage the use of "Planned Gifts" to benefit Qualified Endowments of Montana-based non-profit organizations. A "Qualified Endowment" is a permanent, irrevocable fund that is held by a Montana incorporated or established 501(c)(3) organization, such as the Plentywood Education and Alumni Foundation. The principal or original gift can never be spent. This credit is being offered only until December 31, 2007.

The credit of up to \$10,000 is allowed to an individual, C corporation or estate. The credit is calculated by taking 40% of the present value of the charitable gift portion of a planned gift.

The \$10,000 credit is also allowed for an outright gift if given by a C corporation, S corporation, partnership, trust, estate or limited liability company. For this type of gift, 20% of the value is used in calculating the credit.

The above gift may also qualify for an itemized deduction on your federal tax return. If this sounds good to you, talk to your tax advisor about how you can take advantage of this opportunity.

- ◆ Charitable Remainder Annuity Trust
- ◆ Pooled Income Fund Trust
- ◆ Charitable Lead Unitrust
- ◆ Charitable Lead Annuity Trust
- ◆ Charitable Gift Annuity
- ◆ Deferred Charitable Gift Annuity
- ◆ Charitable Life Estate Agreement
- ◆ Paid-Up Life Insurance Policy.

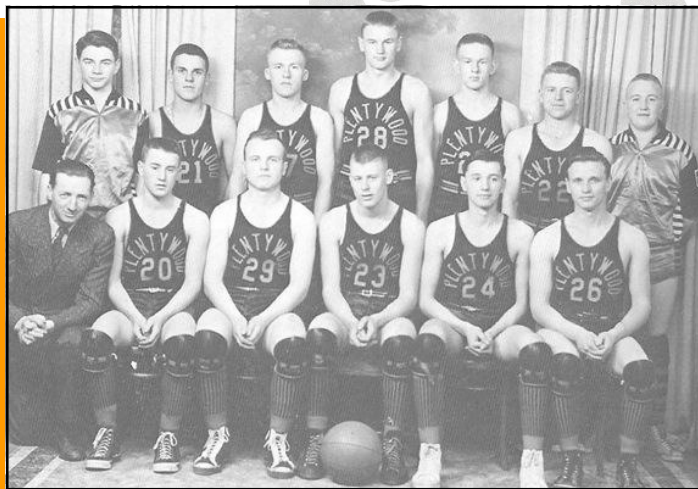

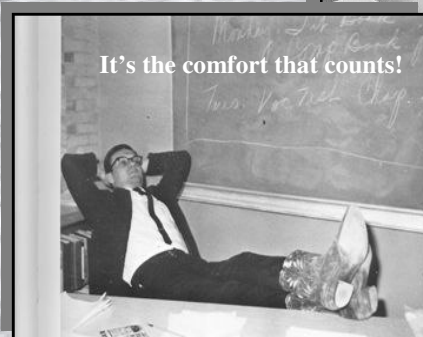
