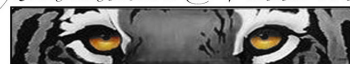

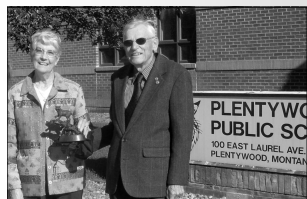
COVER ART COMPETITION

Four years ago when a group of business people and educators from the community approached me about taking on the challenge of helping build a foundation, I did not hesitate. Not for a moment.

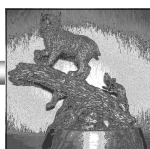
In fact, I welcomed the opportunity to be a part of something that I knew would reconnect those who share my educational roots.

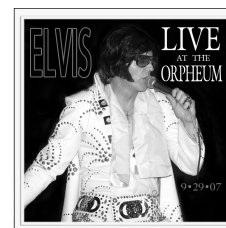


FULL BODY WILDCAT BRONZE

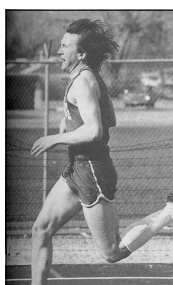

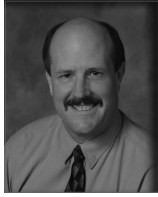

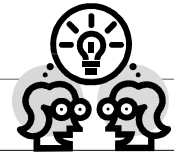
I hope everyone has a happy and cheerful Holiday Season, and thank you again for your support of the Plentywood Education and Alumni Foundation.

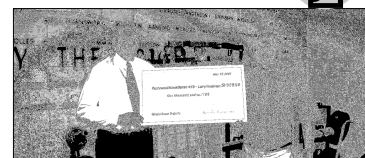

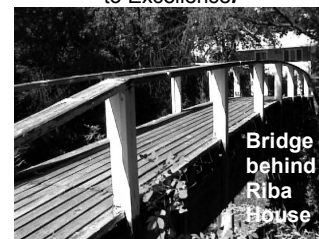

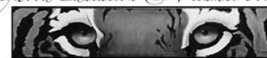
